

COOKIES POLICY

I. Introduction

Capital Com Group Ltd (the **"Company"**, **"we"**, **"Capital Com"**, **"Capital.com"**) is a Cypriot Investment Firm (the **"CIF"**) regulated by the Cyprus Securities and Exchange Commission (the **"CySEC"**) for the provision of investment and ancillary services under the license number 463/25 and registered in the Republic of Cyprus. Our business and registered address is at Vasileiou Makedonos, 8, Kinnis Business Center, 2nd floor, 3040, Limassol, Cyprus.

II. Purpose

Please note that this Policy applies to you when you access and use any part of our website at <https://capital.com/en-eu> or our mobile applications (collectively referred to as the **"Platform"**).

The Company is constantly working on supplementing and improving this Policy. When we make material changes to this Policy, we will notify you through the Platform, or (where reasonable, possible and practicable) via email.

III. Cookies

A cookie is a small text file which may be placed onto your device when you access and use the Platform. We use the term "cookies" to also include other tracking technologies having equivalent or similar effect, such as mobile device identifiers. We use cookies on our Platform to help us recognise you and your device and store some information about your preferences or past actions. Cookies support the integrity of our registration process, retain your preferences and account settings, help evaluate and compile aggregated statistics about user activity and assist with our marketing efforts.

IV. Our use of cookies

The Company may use cookies to:

- recognise you whenever you use the Platform (this speeds up your access as you do not have to log in each time);
- prevent fraud on our Platform;
- remember your preferences and your device so the Platform works as expected;
- provide visitors with the relevant version of the Platform;
- assist with our promotional and marketing efforts;

- carry out research and statistical analysis to help improve our content, products and services and to help us better understand our users' requirements.

V. Type of cookies

There are two types of cookies depending on their lifetime:

- **Session cookies**—these allow us to link your actions during a particular session. These expire each time you close the browser and do not remain on your device afterwards.
- **Persistent cookies**—these are stored on your device in between sessions. These allow your preferences or actions to be remembered. These will remain on your device until they expire, or you delete them from your cache.

By domain, there are first-party and third-party cookies:

- **First-party cookies** are set by the domain pertaining to our Platform; and
- **Third-party cookies** are stored by a different domain to the Platform's domain.

The cookies placed on your device fall into the following categories by their purpose:

- **Strictly necessary cookies** - these cookies are essential for the operation of the Platform and for you to use its features. For example, we may use these cookies to ensure fraud prevention or help you log in to our Platform and fill in forms more easily. We also use these types of cookies to ensure that our Platform is displayed correctly on your device. Without these cookies, services you have asked for may not be provided.
- **Performance cookies** - these cookies allow us to count visits and traffic sources so we can measure and improve the performance of our site. They help us to know which pages are the most and least popular and see how visitors move around the site. If you do not allow these cookies we will not know when you have visited our site and will not be able to monitor its performance. All information collected by these cookies is only used to improve how our Platform works.
- **Targeting cookies** - these cookies are used to deliver adverts more relevant to you and your interests. They may be used to limit the number of times you see an advertisement and help measure the effectiveness of an advertising campaign. They are usually placed by advertising

networks with the Platform operator's permission, and the information collected may be used, for example, to provide measurement services or target ads.

Please note that our cookie consent tool provides more information about the cookies we use, including their purposes and lifespan.

VI. Third Party cookies

Please note that, throughout the Platform, we may link to other websites or applications owned and operated by certain trusted third parties. Some of these third-party websites may also use cookies – which are likely to be analytical, performance or targeting cookies – or similar technologies, in accordance with their own separate cookie policies. For privacy information relating to third-party websites and cookies (over which we have no control) please refer to their policies as appropriate.

For example, we may work with our third party analytics and advertising providers, such as Google and share your data with them to support our marketing efforts (e.g., ad personalization). VII. How to exercise your right to refuse and/or to withdraw consent on your application

The consent tool allows you to control the use of various types of cookies. Strictly necessary cookies cannot be disabled, nor can the tool be used to block cookies on third party websites linked from our website.

Alternatively, you can control the use of cookies on our Platform using the settings of your browser. To disable cookies through your browser, look for the instructions usually located within the "Help," "Tools" or "Edit" menus in your browser. Please note that disabling a cookie or category of cookies does not delete the cookie from your browser unless manually completed through your browser function.
